The Committee discussed issues arising from the Minister's mandate letter. The Secretariat presented a work plan on emerging issues set out in the Minister's letter. The emerging issues will be undertaken in the following order:

- 1. Evaluate the threshold for causation in occupational disease claims
- 2. Examine the current structure supporting the WCB's injury prevention efforts with the aim of maximizing effectiveness to reduce workplace injuries and illness
- 3. Review the Act's provisions relating to the role of WCB health care advisors in the context of workers' right to select their own health care providers
- 4. Review legislative provisions governing wage loss benefits, pensions, and death benefits to assess whether the legislation adequately protects the financial security of injured workers and their families
- 5. Examine legislative provisions related to coverage specifically related to psychological injuries

The Committee also discussed committee members' compensation, the draft Consultation Paper outline including a discussion on whom do we consult, a request from the Minister's office for a LRC work plan, and received an update on the status of the LRC website launch.
